ACADEMIC - Successful completion of Australian Year 12 or equivalent, at minimum, or Certificate IV in a related field.

This course covers the development of complete garment design and manufacture fashion design schemes, working with either a self developed or client brief and within project parameters. It also includes specialist design areas such as textile design and patternmaking. Our course reflects real industry needs and prepares our graduates to be self employed as a fashion designer or fashion stylist.
